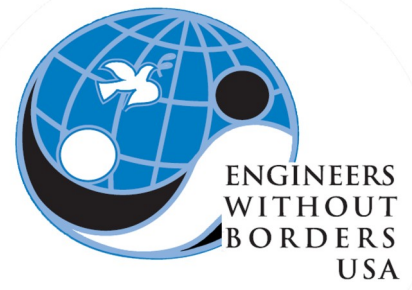

Dr. Amadei is the Faculty Director of the Mortenson Center in Engineering for Developing Communities at the University of Colorado at Boulder and holds the Mortenson Endowed Chair in Global Engineering. He is also the co-founder of the Engineers Without Borders-International network. Among other distinctions, Dr. Amadei is the 2007 co-recipient of the Heinz Award for the Environment, the recipient of the [2008 ENR Award of Excellence](#), and an elected member of the U.S. National Academy of Engineering. Dr. Amadei's work has been featured on National Public Radio, PBS NewsHour, and TIME (US). He is also currently working on his third book entitled “Engineering With Soul.”
