**HAWAII DAM SAFETY SEMINARS 2008**

DLNR Engineering Division and ASCE are hosting the 2008 Dam Safety Seminars. The Dam Safety Seminars will provide:

1. Phase I dam safety inspection summary findings (County specific) and technical information to address common concerns.
2. Emergency Action Plan (EAP) Training and "Table Top" Exercises for each County.

Hawaii Revised Statutes 179D were revised in 2007 updating and adding various Dam Safety requirements.

**Day 1: Dam Safety Inspection Findings for your island and Technical Training on:**

- \* **HAWAII:** General risks & liability, seismic hazards & potential failure modes in seismic areas
- \* **MAUI:** Importance of dam inspections, information about dam instrumentation & review of design and construction for new dams, alterations, and/or repairs of dams.
- \* **OAHU:** Basics of dam safety, hydrological & geotechnical information (continued on Day 3)
- \* **KAUAI:** Addressing vegetation clearing & maintenance, seepage, outlet works & spillway concerns.

**Day 2: Emergency Action Plan (EAP) Training and "Table Top" Exercises**

- \* How to create an EAP with a *fill-in template* and how to update and manage an EAP. Steps for EAP implementation, conducting & running *Table Top Exercises*. Simulated exercises with local emergency response officials.
- \* Note: **EAP's are required for High and Significant classified dams.**

**Day 3: Dam Safety Technical Training on: (OAHU only)** (Due to consultant availability, an additional day of training being offered on Oahu only)

- \* Basics of dam safety, hydrological & geotechnical information (continued from Day 1)
- \* Standard Operating Procedures for Operations & Maintenance, Inspection of dams.
