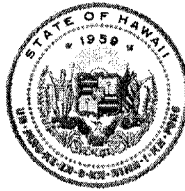
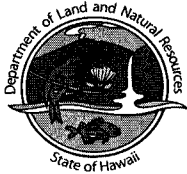

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

This Memorandum of Agreement was made and entered into on this 25<sup>th</sup> day of September 2006, by and between the State of Hawaii, Department of Land and Natural Resources, hereafter referred to as "State", and the Hawaii Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers, hereafter referred to as "ASCE", and is entered into for the purpose of conducting four dam safety training seminars, one on each island, Hawaii, Oahu, Maui, and Kauai.

**RESPONSIBILITIES**

WHEREAS, the State has the responsibility to administer and manage the Dam Safety Program in the State of Hawaii, and to enforce and promote Dam Safety rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Dam Owners in the State are responsible for inspecting and maintaining their facilities, and are most familiar with the conditions of their structures; and

WHEREAS, the Dam Safety Training Seminars provide Dam Owners with the skills needed to assess their own dams and are an integral part of the Dam Safety Program mitigation mission, to reduce the risk to life and property through education and emergency preparedness; and

WHEREAS, ASCE strives for the advancement of the science and profession of engineering within the State of Hawaii, and its members serve as technical advisors and designers to the local Dam Safety Community; and


WHEREAS, ASCE is experienced in organizing, promoting, and conducting seminars in Hawaii.


THEREFORE, be it resolved that the State shall pay ASCE for the full cost of products and services provided, estimated to be valued at approximately ten thousand dollars & no cents (\$10,000). ASCE will provide the following:

- 1) Advertise the training seminars in the ASCE's newsletter, website, and among their members by email.
- 2) Hawaii Training Seminar: Provide refreshment and assistance with facility coordination.

- 3) Oahu Training Seminar: Provide two persons to assist with the registration and other related duties, provide refreshment and assistance with facility coordination. Furnish lei to all speakers.
- 4) Maui Training Seminar: Provide one person to assist with the registration and other related duties, provide refreshment and assistance with facility coordination.
- 5) Kauai Training Seminar: Provide one person to assist with the registration and other related duties, provide refreshment and assistance with facility coordination.

Be it also resolved that person provided by ASCE to assist with registration and other related duties shall be provided with complementary seminar registration at the site where assistance is provided.
