general information

The American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) Hawaii Section seeks nominations for the 2011 Hawaii Outstanding Civil Engineering Achievement (OCEA) Awards. The purpose of this award program is to recognize a variety of projects that demonstrate important and outstanding civil engineering accomplishments by Hawaii's design and construction professionals.

award categories

Nominated projects and research/studies will be considered for eleven award categories. The judging panel will determine the applicable award category for each nomination. Awards may be given in all categories if a sufficient number of worthy nominations are received. Only one project will be selected as the overall winner, designated as the 2011 Hawaii Outstanding Civil Engineering Achievement.



eligibility & judging criteria

To be eligible, projects must have been designed **or** constructed in Hawaii **and** completed within the last two years. The judging panel will award projects and research that demonstrate important and outstanding civil engineering accomplishments. Some of the key judging criteria include:

- Resourcefulness in identifying and solving design challenges
- Contributions to the well-being of people and communities
- Pioneering use of materials and construction methods
- Inventive or new application of civil engineering technologies
- Protection of and reducing impacts to natural resources
- Beneficial effects of the project, including aesthetic value
